Are bed bugs a health and safety issue?

A resurgence in the bed bug population began ten years ago across the United States. Ohio has been particularly hard hit with infestations occurring state-wide. Our presentation this month will address bed bug anatomy, infestation prevention for work and home, and practical advice for pest control.

Courtney Myers holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Wildlife Biology from the University of Rhode Island and is a current Master of Public Health student at Kent State University. She has been at the Stark County Health Department for eleven years as a Registered Sanitarian and Program Coordinator. As a founding member of the Stark County Bed Bug Prevention Task Force, she has presented across the state on the biology of bed bugs. Courtney holds a Pest Control License with the Department of Agriculture. Before moving into public health, she was a Director of a non-profit environmental education program.
